## Home Discussion

“Serving the Lord” involves our commitment as a family, beginning with our parents. We serve the Lord by helping and working with others. During the month of March, we enter the season of Great Lent when we focus upon the lessons of prayer, good works and fasting.

**Prayer:** In addition to praying in church together, what are the times when we can pray together as a family? In addition to praying at meals, begin planning a regular time of prayer as a family, especially to remember others.

**Good Works:** Consider ways of helping a family member, a friend, classmate, or co-worker, as a family. Someone who you may know, has a need and may need help.

**Fasting:** Think of the ways that you could change how you use your time, the kind of meals you eat and ways of spending your money, in order to focus upon serving the Lord.

## Calendar

**March 6 - The Sunday of the Last Judgment (“Meat Fare”).** We are reminded that we will all face a day of Judgment when those who have served the Lord Jesus Christ by serving others will be welcomed into His Kingdom [Matthew 25:31-46]

**March 13 - The Sunday of Forgiveness (“Cheese Fare”).** God forgives us as we also forgive others [Matthew 6:14-21]

**March 20 - The “Sunday of Orthodoxy.”** Jesus calls His disciples (Philip and Nathaniel) saying, “Follow me!” They recognize Him as who Moses wrote: “the Son of Joseph” who is also the “Son of God.” [John 1:43-51]

**March 25 - The Feast of the Annunciation** [Luke 1:24-38] The Archangel Gabriel announces to the Virgin Mary that she is to give birth to Jesus: Christ, the Lord.

**March 27 - The Second Sunday of Lent.** [Mark 2:1-12] Jesus heals a man unable to walk thanks to the help of four men of faith who brought the man to Jesus through the opening in the roof of a building where he was.
